Prague, Czech Republic August 20, 2014: Discussions and Bible study encompassed topical questions like, 'In what time do we now live and how close are we to go home to our Lord? What is the glory of Jesus? What is the unforgivable sin, and what is sin against the Holy Spirit? How, as Christians, are we supposed to handle the 'ups and downs' of our daily lives?'

Pastor Benjamin Altschul also addressed the spiritual gifts in today's churches, "God is not slow to give His people gifts, admonition and help. We

need to work in the gifts of the Holy Spirit that have been given to His church. The gifts of power, prophecy and healing are nothing you do yourself; it is all grace and the only condition that exists for us to operate in them is that we must have a relationship with Jesus (John 15)."

Following each study session, Pastor Altschul administered prayer for healing and restoration. Testimonies shared among the attendees revealed that many people were touched visibly and some invisibly. One of the Czech Pastors reported, "I have been in several meetings like this before, but this is the first time I felt so vividly the power of the Holy Spirit go through me."

Also according to Pastor Altschul, "As I travel to multiple countries throughout Europe and the Americas, I find that conventions like these are especially

important to those who are preparing their hearts for Jesus as outlined in Matthew 25:10, because without Him; we can do nothing."
